项目说明:

QUANT是位于斯图加特的一幢新建豪华公寓项目。它是由20世纪60年代的一幢实验室改建而成的。为了让潜在买家可以感受到QUANT公寓设计的巨大潜在价值，地主L&W Immobilien GmbH创造了与斯图加特地区极为协调的出色公寓模式。ippolito Feltz创造的内部设计与Wilford Schupp设计的精致高雅的外部十分匹配。

设计理念是要创造一个超越平凡的居住环境，但同时又要接近真实的生活，获取完美的生活方式。与阁楼空间类似，公寓确实是一个大方得体的连续空间。我们可以从一些有利角度来领会其整体设计。所有的功能安置是在自由地界定区域。如果需要，可以使用滑门和沉重的窗帘来划分空间。这样，一个全新而精致的内部格局和外部景观就呈现在眼前了。

宽敞的厨房带独立式橱柜和大餐台，在这里可以享受烹饪乐趣。厨房构成了整个公寓的焦点。镜面天花使人对用餐区印象深刻，它被屏风与软座景观分隔开来。这使得用餐者可以把厨房、起居区和露台的景观一览无遗。沙发与圆形大矮凳、矮桌和液晶大电视相搭配。灯光效果可以无限变化，以适应不同气氛。独立式木质壁炉在冬天是温暖的港湾，南边有一个附属的小图书室，在此可安静地读书或享受悠闲的二人早餐时光。

睡房和工作室的设计十分私密。当你带领客人参观的时候，可以从他们的表情上感受到羡慕之情。睡房和书房形成一个整体空间，由橡木环成的圈、封装墙、地板和天花区分开。分隔墙安装了滑门来隔开两个区域，同时形成了床的靠头和书桌的靠背。这个睡房的设计让你可以凝视卧室窗外的风景或者观看内置液晶电视中播放的惊悚片。睡房后面是书房。一张坐卧两用长椅和沉重的窗帘让客人在晚上也可以享有美好舒适的时刻。浴室通过一个公寓内部的大窗口进行天然采光。在独立式浴缸享受完沐浴或清爽的花洒淋浴后，一个大衣柜则是你准备上班或出席晚宴之前的绝佳去处。

流畅的房间设计理念由巧妙组合的材料和色调所支持：优雅简洁的橄榄绿、环氧树脂涂层地板、橡木表层、白色漆饰面。感性的面料和多彩的墙壁相互进行令人兴奋的“对话”，当然该公寓的居住者也参与其中。

Project Description:

QUANT is a new luxury apartment project in Stuttgart. It is a conversion of an old 1960s laboratory building. In order to give potential buyers a feeling for the numerous design possibilities inherent in a QUANT apartment, the landlord L&W Immobilien GmbH has created an exceptional model apartment in cooperation with acclaimed partners from the Stuttgart area. Ippolito Feltz group has created an interior to complete the building's sophisticated exterior designed by Wilford Schupp.

The concept is about creating a living environment that goes far beyond the average and approaches what living is really about: getting the most out of life. Similar to a loft space, the apartment is immediately tangible as a generous, continuous space. It can be apprehended in its entirety from certain vantage points. All functions are accommodated in freely defined areas, which can be closed off by means of sliding doors and heavy curtains, if so desired. In this way, a whole range of new and beautiful framed interior and exterior vistas become apparent.

The spacious kitchen with its free-standing cooking block and expansive dining table cater for an enjoyment of the culinary arts and form the main focal point of the apartment. A mirrored ceiling lends impressive definition to the dining area, which is separated from the soft seating landscape by an open room divider. This enables the diner to keep kitchen,



living area and terrace in full view. The sofa is complemented by a capacious pouf, a low table and a pivotable LCD television. The lighting can be adjusted to suit the mood by means of a infinitely variable, dimmable, illuminated ceiling. A free-standing wood-burning fire is a source of cosy warmth in the winter. On the south side, the adjoining small library offers an area for peaceful reading or enjoying a relaxed breakfast.

The private part of the apartment is designed around sleeping, working and enjoying the expression on guests' faces when you show them around. The bedroom and study room form a common zone, defined by a circle of oak, enclosing wall, floor and ceiling. The dividing wall has integrated the sliding doors to separate the two areas, and simultaneously serves as a headrest for the bed and a back to the desk. The bedroom design gives you the freedom to choose between letting your gaze travel out of the bedroom window or watching a thriller on the built-in LCD television. Behind the bedroom lies the study. A daybed and heavy curtain ensure that guests have comfortable quarters in which to spend the night. The bathroom is lit by natural light through a generous window giving on to the interior of the apartment. After you've enjoyed a long soak in the free-standing bathtub or refreshed your senses under the rain shower, the walk-in wardrobe is the perfect place to get ready for the office or dress up for a night out.

The flowing room concept is supported by an ingenious composition of materials and colours: the elegant, olive green, epoxy resin-coated floor, oak wood surfaces, white varnished finishes, sensual fabrics and coloured walls engage in an exciting dialogue with one another and, of course, with the apartment's occupants.
