As a result of growth in staff numbers, the architects and communication designers of this firm worked together to create a new workplace on a single floor in an old office building. The design of the space is in accordance with the firm's own standards as 'identity architects' – the office is the hallmark that conveys its identity to both clients and staff.

Two long work desks cultivate a creative and communicative atmosphere.

Shelving and furniture feature white and dark wood. Contrasting accents of colour are provided by textile bands above the work desks that serve as light switches, and from areas of green plants.

In addition to two conference rooms, cheerful communication islands are available for discussions. The studio, with its spacious kitchen and oversized mirror, is a place for inspiration and relaxation.








- 2 Wall system opposite the reception desk
