Ippolito Fleitz Group is a multidisciplinary design studio founded by Peter Ippolito and Gunter Fleitz in 2002. Their 480-square-metre office in Stuttgart was designed by the company and completed in 2008.

Our studio is situated in a former factory for control technology in the west of Stuttgart. The five-storey Gründerzeit building was originally constructed at the turn of the last century to house an industrial laundry. Largely reconstructed after the war due to heavy bombing damage, the first floor of the building retains something of its original character as a production facility. The four-metre-high ceiling is supported by cast-iron pillars, a feature rarely found in Stuttgart, giving the space a nostalgic feel. With a floor area of almost 500 square metres, the studio provides the necessary space for free, creative thinking.

The nucleus of our office is the studio. Here, people from different design disciplines work on projects in concert. The open-plan interior was specifically selected to encourage cross-pollination and creative intercourse, fostering an interdisciplinary design process.





Reflecting the studio's conceptualisation as 'identity architects', our premises were designed as a quasi-signature trademark for clients and studio staff alike.
