# Show Flat

True to its name, this 250sqm show apartment features a full range of grey nuances in premium materials, textures and high-contrast surfaces. A spacious living-dining area with an integrated floor-to-ceiling kitchen extends the full width of the apartment. From the north-facing balcony, through the interior to the opposite horizon, nothing in the apartment blocks the lines of sight. Zoning the living and dining areas is a painted aluminium-slat ceiling, which also provides indirect lighting, and nearly invisible filigreed glass shelves between the dining table and couch arrangement. Herringbone-patterned parquet flooring in dark grey, with highlights of green and blue, is the foundation for the shades of grey theme. Various textured plaster and paint enliven a 20m-long wall opposite the entrance.

In the living area, layered carpets meet textured fabrics, smooth marble and mirror-glass surfaces, with earth- and gold-toned accessories. Separated from the living area by floor-to-ceiling glass is a small, half-open workspace with a comfortable sofa corner.

Grained Chinese marble is used on kitchen worktops and the walls of the bedrooms and the bathrooms, which have unpretentious white sanitary items and accessories in black and gold.
