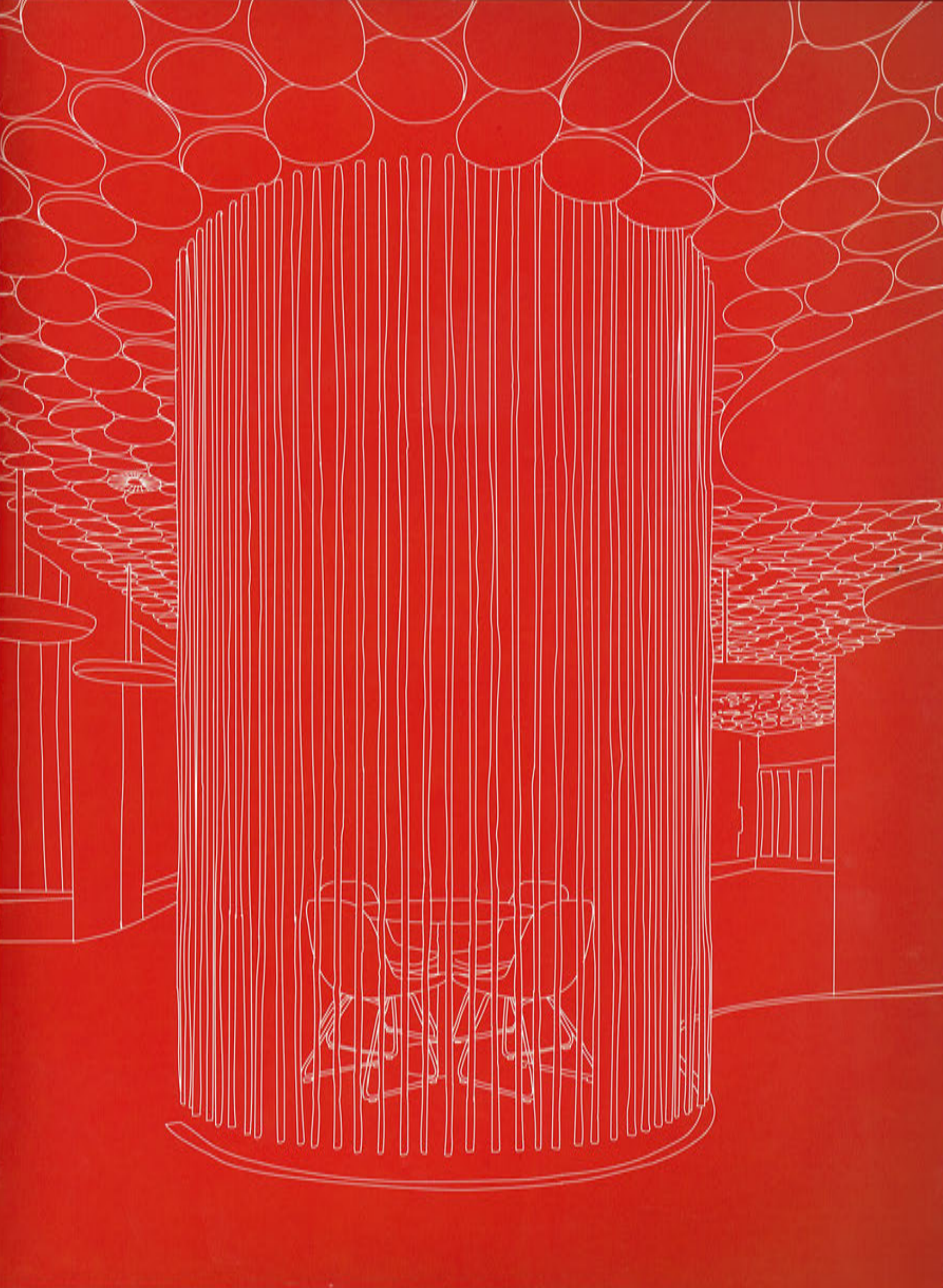

Whether fast and casual, like Soliscolomer y Asociados' McCafé in Guatemala, or the highest of haute cuisine, as in New York's Rainbow Room by Gabellini Sheppard Associates, these projects delight all the senses. Often, firms make a feature of looking up: See the "liquid" canopy of red-lit panels that pour from the ceiling at Belzberg Architects' Conga Room, or the undulating felt cones at PS Studio and Thomas Klein's Pintxos, a dry bar in Kuwait. Sometimes, though, the grandest drama isn't indoors. To wit: the enormous LED soda bottle that glows outside Elliott + Associates Architects' Route 66 gas station and fast-food joint. *A tasting menu of design delights.*
