

## Palace of International Forums

Tashkent

The Palace of International Forums in Uzbekistan is located on Amir-Timur square, in the center of Tashkent. This is the most important building in the country and serves as a platform for acts of state, congresses, conferences and cultural highlights. The architects' task was to give the interior a more modern appearance that also incorporated the traditional elements of Uzbek architecture. As a result, the rooms are cosmopolitan and communicative with a material consistency. Ornamentation, an organic movement, crystals and precious metals, as well as a delicate play of artwork and sunlight were all sources of inspiration for the design.





